problems," he said, "not just treating your symptoms. To really target the problem directly, you have to determine the exact cause. The whole aspect of relating allergy and immunology is cutting-edge medicine."

And to provide this care, he returned to the North Texas area where he was raised. "Plano is a wonderful place to raise a family, and I want to be involved in making sure people enjoy every aspect of living here. But along with our landscape comes a host of allergens—mountain cedar, grasses, weeds, trees, molds, pets, dust mites, etc.—that are acerbated by the fact that we don't have coastal breezes to clear them away. Everything just pools around in a humid prairie land here."

Eric R. Kavosh, M.D., graduated from the University of Texas at Austin. After obtaining his medical degree, he completed his residency in internal medicine and a fellowship in allergy/immunology at UMDNJ in Newark, New Jersey, plus a fellowship in allergy/immunology at UT Southwestern in Dallas. He is dual board-certified in Allergy and Immunology as well as Internal Medicine. Before opening his private practice, he worked as a hospitalist and emergency room physician at several hospitals in North Texas. He's a member of several professional organizations, including the American Medical Association, the American Academy of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology, and the American College of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology.



Although his varied interests include baseball, theater and scuba diving, he knew he wanted to be a physician since junior high school. "I couldn't dream of doing anything else," he said. "It's the most amazing fusion of science and art. An exceptional physician must be on the cutting-edge of science and medicine, but I quickly realized you have to be able to relate to people. It doesn't matter how much you know, you're not going to be able to deliver a message to people—one they'll be receptive to—unless they're comfortable about being open with you. That's my greatest achievement."













said. "The first step in establishing effective treatment is determining the cause." Therefore he can employ a variety of testing—depending on the patient and his or her symptoms—for concerns such as:

Patch Testing For Chemicals Or Industrial Exposures

General Allergy Testing For Pollens, Pets, And Dust Mites(Usually Through The Skin)

Asthma Breathing Tests (To Determine Severity)

Rhinoscopy (Sinus Disease Testing) Food And Drug Allergy Testing

Venom Allergy Testing—Fire Ants, Bees, Wasps, Hornets

In addition to creating an upbeat, contemporary practice, Dr. Kavosh invested in a Fotona—a state-of-the-art laser used to provide a variety of aesthetic and medical treatments. "Since my patients come for allergy and immunology care, it just made sense to be able to provide them with laser aesthetic and medical treatments they might be seeking elsewhere," he said. "This way they're being treated by a certified and extensively-trained physician and not someone who has just been laser-trained."
